### Important Information

The Short Break opportunities in this activity programme can only be accessed by Shropshire children and young people aged up to 18 years of age who have a disability or additional needs that make (or would make) attending mainstream clubs, groups or facilities difficult.

To confirm your child/young person is eligible to access the 'All In' opportunities you are required to complete a registration form which details the nature of your child/young person's disability or additional needs as well as describing the barriers they have, or would face in accessing mainstream services.

Alternatively you can complete an online form or download a copy via Shropshire Council's website **www.shropshire.gov.uk** (search: 'Short Breaks' and follow the links to Short Breaks 'All In' activity programmes).

Once the completed 'All In' Registration Form has been submitted/returned, each child/ young person will be sent their own 'All In' membership card and number.

You can then start to book onto the opportunities using their membership number.

#### Please note:


- You must book onto the opportunities available. Providers reserve the right to turn people away if they have not booked.
  - Unless otherwise stated please book onto an opportunity 7 days in advance so that copies of registration forms can be distributed to the provider.
- The 'All In' programme provides different opportunities for children/young people with different needs. Some activities may not be suitable for every child/ young person.
- Parents/Carers may be required to stay for the duration of the activity. Please discuss this with the provider when booking and also whether they are able to cater for the needs of your child/young person.
  - Your child/young person may be able to access more opportunities when accompanied by a responsible adult or their familiar support worker.
- All opportunities are subject to availability and eligibility.

### Short Breaks - what do they mean to you?

We have worked hard over the last few years with our local providers to offer a varied Short Breaks programme that is valued and makes a real difference.

We ask all our providers to gather feedback from children, young people and the parents and carers that have attended the 'All In' Short Breaks so we can see how we're doing.

These are some of the comments we've received (names have been changed as appropriate).

#### **Shropshire Youth Association**

'They really look forward to activities and feel that they belong. It is the only out of school activity they go to so is so important. Thank you for pushing the boundaries which means we try new things – if they can do it so can we'!

#### The New Saints FC Foundation

'It's so good to finally find a club my son fits in to. He has tried many sports clubs but none of them were prepared for his severe learning disability and doesn't access any after school activities'

#### Cycling/Sat club at the Sports Village

The difference it has made to my child's confidence is amazing. It is the first club she has ever been to that they understand her disability and she feels comfortable.

The swimming, cycling and moving and grooving club have made such a difference to her muscles, her strength, fitness and ability to join in. Thank you ... the difference these activities make to our children is great.

#### **Tickwood farm**

'I felt I must write to you regarding Llama Cabin short break scheme in Much Wenlock.

Our son has severe anxiety issues around other people ... it is a struggle to get him to leave the house. Due to the cabin being remote and secluded, with no one but the cows in the field around - he relaxed and had a huge smile on his face for the first time in months! He LOVED it! He LOVED everything about it! What a fabulous idea, we are truly grateful for this opportunity. Tickwood have a great thing going, educational, accessible and affordable'.

### Shropshire Youth Association



SYA has a team of qualified experienced Youth Workers who will enable and support young people to integrate into their friendly group of young people with additional needs or disabilities. All workers have DBS, safeguarding and first aid training.

Following a consultation with young people, parents and carers earlier this year a request for more regular meetings where the whole group could meet up was made.

Parents and carers also said that there was a need to raise awareness around important issues like drugs and alcohol, staying safe in the community and on-line, emergency first aid, food hygiene and basic life skills training.

As a result of this SYA will be offering a series of fun and interactive workshops such as a 'ghosts and ghouls' night which will be full of first aid related team challenges with fake wounds and blood in first aid scenarios.

Full details and venues for these workshops will be available with booking forms from 1st March 2017.

Transport from designated pick up points in Bridgnorth and Shrewsbury will be provided.

#### Lower Bush Farm



Lower Bush Farm is a stunning 40 acre farm on the side of the Brown Clee Hill 6 miles from Ludlow, south Shropshire.

The Farm has three Forest School woodlands on site which are fantastic for making dams and dens, climbing, running, rolling, hiding, swinging in hammocks, getting muddy and toasting marshmallows.

In the Forest School area children make bird boxes, wooden xylophones, mallets, willow sculptures, giant wooden meccano, and swings to rig up in the woods.

Children will get wet and muddy splashing through the streams and woods so they will need to wear old clothes, waterproofs and welly boots.

The centre want everyone to have a great time, so please get in touch to discuss any concerns or particular needs or if a half day would suit your child better.
