<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You have been provided with a writing activity booklet for each year group.• There is a selection of writing tasks which children can work through each day, these activities link to creativity through picture-based questions and video prompts. Pupils have done similar tasks in SODA activities so should be familiar with the tasks.• Log on to Read Write inc to find a daily video for pupils to watch, if appropriate• As well as this there is a poetry activity and a film review/ storyboard activity for pupils to complete in their own time. These are additional tasks if pupils wish to complete them.• You have also been provided with reading comprehension tasks that link to the topic of America or Rainforests, answers are also provided.• There is also a SPaG and Spellings folder filled with resources. Year 5 Start with the 1-star sheets and move up to the 2/3-star sheets if pupils want a challenge. Year 6 Start with the 2 star and move up to 3 stars if pupils want to challenge themselves.

To add to their learning in this topic, children could:

1. Research any previous president of the United States of America (not Donald Trump) and create a fact file about their life and what they achieved as President.
2. Create a meal made of only Fairtrade items and label a map of the world to show where your food came from.
3. Research another famous American and write a letter to Mr. Paterson to persuade him to teach about this person in the future. Why are they important? Why do we still care about them? (Rosa Parks, Neil Armstrong, Muhammad Ali etc.)

PowerPoints of information and selected resources have been provided, if resources are not provided pupils should be able to create their own out of plain or lined paper. Within each subject there are at least 3 lessons which should be taken at your own pace, if pupils are interested and ask for extra tasks or if extra information is required, please contact Mr. Paterson. Some lessons have a range of activities, pupils can pick which activity they would like to complete on the topic.
