Autumn term 2020

Our topic this term is: The Industrial Revolution!

English – writing	Pathways to write: This term we will be writing a narrative based on the story of 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne.
Maths	White Rose Maths units: Place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.
Science	I can identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating. I can recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. I can find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it. I can find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it. I can recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
Geography	I can locate and name the continents on a World Map and locate the main countries of Europe inc. Russia. I can identify capital cities of Europe. I can locate and name the countries making up the British Isles, with their capital cities. I can identify longest rivers in the world, largest deserts, highest mountains. I can compare a region of the UK with a region in Europe, eg. local hilly area with a flat one or under sea level.
Art	Painting and collage. To be able to paint a picture inspired by the Industrial Revolution in the style of JMW Turner- romanticism.
RE	Learning about the Trinity? (Core learning – Baptism and the Grace). What are festivals of light?
DT	I can sew fabric together and make more than one kind of stitch. I can cut materials safely and accurately using the correct tools, I can choose suitable techniques to construct products.
