

Tilstock C.E. Primary School and Nursery PE and Sports Grant:

Financial Year 2016/17: £ 8000

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic year to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - has been allocated to primary school head teachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. Each school is free to determine how best to use this funding and we have decided to use it in the following ways:-

Employ a swimming coach to help to train staff and work with the children so that all classes in school can attend swimming lessons.

Employ a sports coach to work alongside staff to deliver a variety of sports throughout the school year.

Pay for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport.

Provide additional after school coaching.
