SATs Week

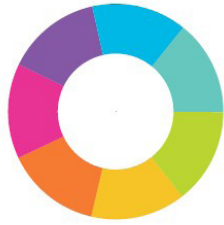
Assessment week for both Year 2 and Year 6 pupils is fast approaching and the children are working very hard towards these.

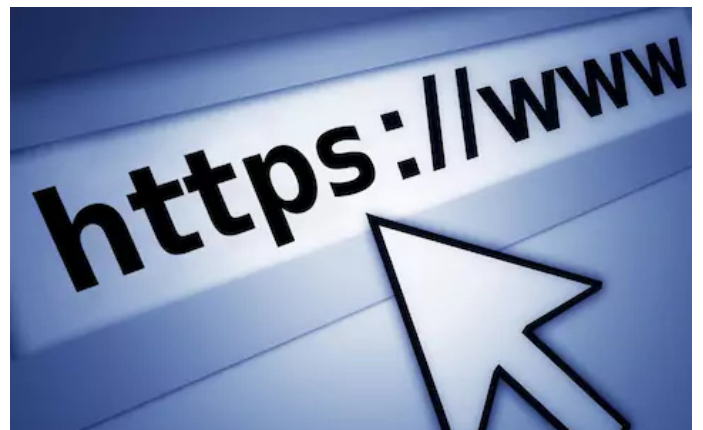
