We will be holding a meeting at school on **Friday 4th May** at **2pm** if any parents would like to come and offer their help and support in organising the event.

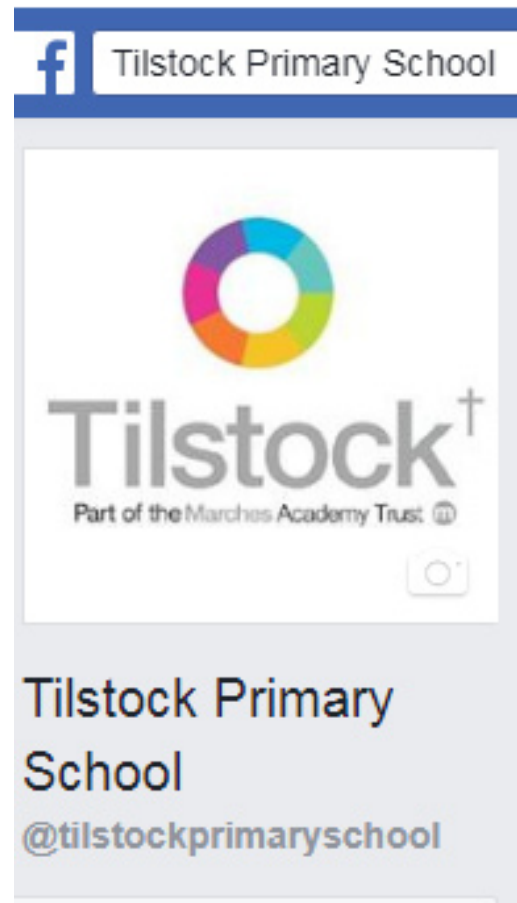

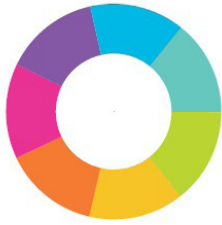
Our logo has been finalised and you will start to see it around the school and on the website.
