Term Dates

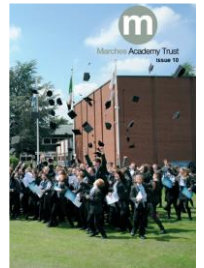
Just a reminder that after the summer holidays, the pupils will return on Tuesday 3rd September 2019.
