Daily Literacy Learning Tasks overview

Wednesday 6th	Read 'Incy Wincy Spider' to your child. Repeat it together with actions. Cut up the four sentences from the shortened version (see resources). Keep them in the right order as you introduce them to your child. The only word that your child will not yet be able to decode (read) is 'spider.' Tell them this word. Point out the word 'The.' Ask your child to point wherever they see 'The.' Repeat with 'is.' Ask your child to count the words in each sentence before they read that sentence. Encourage your child to point to each word as they read it.
Thursday 7th	Find a video of a spider spinning a web and watch it with your child. Talk about it together introducing new vocabulary, e.g. observe, scurry, busy, climb. If you know of a spider's web outside, go and look at it together. Can you see the spider? Are any flies or other bugs trapped in the web? Explain to your child how

	strong the web is and how it withstands wind and rain. Your child can draw a web and then write a label or caption to go with it
	e.g. web, cobweb, spider on a web. Ask your child to read their
	writing to you.
Friday 8th	Start by talking together about what happens in Incy Wincy
	Spider, and the order in which it happens. Use the four sentences
	(shortened version of Incy Wincy Spider) from Session 1 and
	muddle their order. Encourage your child to read the sentences
	out loud. Challenge your child to put the sentences in the right
	order. Your child could draw a picture for each sentence. Encourage
	your child to read the sentences in the correct order to you.

Wednesday	Ice Melting Competition
	Children to think about how ice melts and water evaporates,
	what is needed for it to happen quickly? Once children have
	discussed this concept, give them each a piece of ice, with the
Thursday	competition being who will make it melt the quickest. Describe the wind
1 Mar Salay	Children will make a kite and use it to determine which direction
	the wind is blowing in. First, they will need to cut a diamond
	shape out of an old plastic bag. They can paint their kite if they
	wish. Children will then need two wooden skewers to atach to
	their diamond. The skewers should fit the length and height of
	the diamond shape and cross over in the middle. Where they cross
	over, tie one end of a long piece of string around them. Stick the
	ends of the skewers to the corners of the diamond. Loop the
	other end of the string around an empty toilet roll. When children
	fly their kite, ask them which way they think the wind is blowing
	from. If it is not a windy enough day for the kites to fly on their
	own in the wind, children can run and pull their kites along with
eraid au	them. This should help get them in the air.
Friday	Make Snow!
	Add a little bicarbonate of soda to some shaving foam in a bowl, and mix well with a fork. Slowly add a little water and continue to
	mix until you get a consistency like snow. Ask the pupils to weigh
	the mixture they have made and write how much their mixture
	weighs onto a sticky note along with their name. As pupils finish
	weighing their mixture ask them to place their sticky note on the
	board. Pupils need to compare their results and sort their sticky
	note into an ordinal number starting with the smallest number
	first and the greatest number being last. Ask pupils to make
	simple statements. Snow Scene Collage

Once the pupils have finished making their snow they can use it to make a snow scene collage. Include cut out pictures from magazines, twigs, tissue paper, drawings, etc.
