Please log onto class dojo each day where you will find a daily short video from your teacher, explaining each day's tasks. If you have trouble logging in or need access, please contact your child's teacher.

Daily Maths Learning Tasks overview

Monday	Symmetry – Reflect the lines to complete the picture. Explore mirrors.
Tuesday	Symmetry – Reflect the shapes across the line of symmetry.
Wednesday	Lines of Symmetry – Cut and fold shapes to find their lines of symmetry.
Thursday	Lines of Symmetry – Cut and fold shapes to find their lines of symmetry.
Friday	Lines of Symmetry – Finding more than one line of symmetry on a shape.

Daily Literacy Learning Tasks overview

Monday	Write a diary in first person.
Tuesday	Write instructions/rules for looking after dragons.
Wednesday	Turn the instructions into a leaflet.
Thursday	Describe a place. Where would a dragon live?
Friday	Create our own character based on our class book.

Topic/Science/RE Work task overview

Monday	History – How was WW1 fought? Use the BBC Bitesize website to learn about how and where WW1 was fought.
Tuesday	History – Learning about trenches. What were they like? Bonus Challenge – Make a trench!
Wednesday	Science – Living, Dead, Never Alive Discuss the importance of classifying objects and animals. Sort/classify animals into 3 categories. Create a poster about hunting.
Thursday	History – Learn about the Christmas Day Truce and Armistice Day. Watch videos and draw pictures to support this learning.
Friday	RE – Islam: Muhammad Learn about the story of Muhammad and why he is so important to so many people around the world.
