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Please log onto class dojo each day where you will find a daily short video from your teacher, explaining each day's tasks. If you have trouble logging in or need access, please contact your child's teacher.

Each day there will be a daily maths task, daily literacy task along with a daily topic task.

When each task is completed – your child's work can be uploaded to their profile on Class Dojo where your child's teacher can view completed work. They can then 'mark' and provide 'feedback' specific to your child.

Daily Maths Learning Tasks overview

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| Monday | Time – Practice o'clock and half past. |
| Tuesday | Time – Learn about quarter past. |
| Wednesday | Time – Learn about quarter to. |
| Thursday | Time – Practice quarter past and quarter to. |
| Friday | Time – Practice all: o'clock, half past, quarter past, and quarter to. |

Daily Literacy Learning Tasks overview

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| Monday | Oral Retell. Orally retell our class story. Video it for me to see! |
| Tuesday | Adapt the Story. We are building up to an independent write where you will create your own story. To help you, we will adapt our current class story to provide the structure of your new story. |
| Wednesday | Independent Write – Beginning. Write the beginning of your own story. This must be done as independently as possible. But I will give you as much support as possible from school. |
| Thursday | Independent Write – Middle. Carry on with your story. |
| Friday | Independent Write – End. Finish your story. |

Topic/Science/RE Work task overview

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| Monday | Science – Adaptations. We will be learning how animals survive in such harsh habitats, such as deserts and the north pole. |
| Tuesday | Science - Design an Animal. Design and make your own animal. However, this animal must live either, in the polar regions, desert, ocean, or on the moon. You must explain what adaptations your animal has that helps it to survive in these harsh habitats. |
| Wednesday | History – WW2: Winston Churchill. We will learn about Winston Churchill and his involvement in WW2. Draw a portrait of him and research some of his famous quotes. |
| Thursday | History – WW2: Adolf Hitler. We will learn about Adolf Hitler and his involvement in WW2. Draw a portrait of him and choose which of the facts you find the most interesting. |
| Friday | RE – Islam: Prayer and Mosques. We will learn about Prayer (one of the 5 pillars of faith). We will discover how Muslims pray, why they pray, and when they pray. We will also learn about Mosques. |
