Our Behaviour Learning Ladders

Also on display in every classroom is a 'behaviour ladder' so that children can track their behaviour. The ladder is made up of colours/emoji-type faces which show whether a child is demonstrating 'Outstanding' or 'Good' behaviour, or if they have had a warning, or a sanction.

You will find a chart like this one in your classroom, and also in the school hall.

You will start the day on 'good' - this will be white.

Yellow means you have been given a warning about your behaviour. Your name will be moved onto the yellow part of the chart. You will lose 1 dojo.

If your behaviour does not get better after your warning, you will be moved to the red section of the chart. You could be moved straight here if you do something serious.

When your name is on the red section, you will receive a consequence for your actions.

If your behaviour is fantastic all through the day, or you show some incredible behaviour, you will be moved onto the green section. It is a real achievement to end the day on green. If you do, you will receive 5 dojos.
