Our Learning Leaders were busy this week reporting their views on the learning going on in their classrooms. It's really important for our children to feel that their opinions and views on the curriculum are listened to and valued. This week we focused on Maths and Writing and they have initiated some great ideas for some curriculum enhancements in the term to come.

This term, we will be holding our summer Poetry by Heart event. This term, across the school, each class will learn a new poem, off by heart. WORSHIP


