Dear Parents and Carers.

This week we have not taken our foot of the peddle where learning is concerned. We have launched two projects for the last few weeks of term, for our children to show off their talents.

Our Summer Spelling Bee will take place on the last week of term. Our termly Spelling Bees raise the profile of spelling and provide children with a purposeful and engaging way to learn.

All pupils will take part by learning their year group or phase word list within class and at home, and then compete in a whole class spelling test before competing in the Ultimate Final in a virtual whole school Summer Spelling Bee during the last week of term. The spellings can be found here and have all been taken from the National Curriculum (2014) statutory spellings lists.

Our student Speech Days will take place over the next few weeks. Children will be asked to choose a subject from their class topic this term and then select a piece of learning that they would like to share and present with their class. This could be anything from across the curriculum. They will be asked to think about how they would like to present it. They could use use props or a power-point presentation. You could help your child by looking at their class curriculum planners here to remind you of all the different units of work they have covered.

Maybe Plants, rocks or forces in Science; The Victorians, Vikings or Stoneage in History; or how about Oceans, Rivers or exploration in Geography? The choice is yours!

We will share a selection of these on our website. We can't wait to see them!




REMINDERS & NOTICES
