Dear Parents and Carers,

Christmas is always a busy time in schools. Traditionally, we would arrange a variety of exciting activities such as Christmas performances, carol concerts, school fairs and Christmas parties. We have had to make careful decisions as to what can and can't go ahead this year. Each school is very different, and I will make decisions based on factors that apply to our school. These factors include the number of covid cases, the spaces available in school, corridor spaces, ventilation and so on. We will be continually risk assessing all planned events using guidance from the DfE and from Shropshire Council. The local infection rate for Covid 19 will need to be monitored together with any national restrictions, which could impact on the performances going ahead. Further details of any planned performance will be sent to you over the coming days.

We have reviewed our maths curriculum and feel that we need more opportunity for our children to practice their core mathematical facts - this included number-bonds, addition and subtraction facts and multiplication tables. We have therefore launched the 99 club! All pupils will begin at the 11 Club. They will have the questions in their maths books and a copy to take home. They will have weekly opportunity to answer all calculations at their current level, unaided and within five minutes. If all the calculations are answered correctly twice in a row, the child moves up to the next level! More details are included in the
