
THE BARNES THEATRE

Today we held our annual Harvest service in Christ Church Tilstock with Reverend Sue. Our lovely little church was filled with songs and readings, poems, and food gifts. This year was very special as we decided to create a small but special Harvest teaparty in our school hall, for the children to enjoy, after our church service, so that pupils, staff, and the church could come together to share food and mark the occasion.

The concept of a harvest festival dates back to Victorian times, with the earliest recorded harvest service taking place in Cornwall in 1843! So, we know there is a long-standing British value of celebrating harvest, which makes it such a special time of year, not just in the farming calendar but also for churches and schools to gather to celebrate the food our farmers produce. I have lovely memories of singing harvest songs when I was a child at primary school, songs such as 'Autumn days' and 'We plough the fields and scatter' and it is lovely to see those traditions remain in an ever-changing world. The event always prompts such interesting discussions between staff and children about where our food comes from, so it is also a great opportunity to teach children where their food comes from, and the journey it makes from farm to fork.

Badger Class visited Pizza Express in Shrewsbury this week to learn some important cooking basics, such as washing hands, staying safe in the kitchen, healthy eating and creating and making recipes. The pizzaiolo (pizza chef) also showed our Badgers how to make a famous, Italian classic: the Margherita, before kneading the dough and adding a range of delicious toppings the children had a fab time and were so well behaved!
