The workshops are delivered virtually via MS Teams or face to face at a venue in Shropshire. Our workshops run for 5 weeks from the start date excluding the School Holidays.

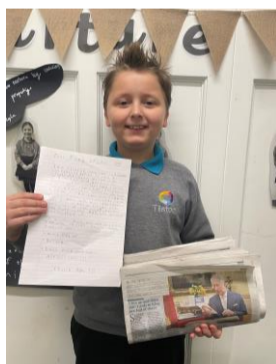
